

## About Our New Studio

**Dance Floors** - Our new floors are our pride and joy! We now have over 2650 sq ft of beautiful sprung maple hardwood dance floor to boogie on - about 1725 downstairs and about 925 upstairs.

**Parking** - There is plenty of paved parking surrounding our studio. We have four spots designated for us specifically but there is community parking on the north side of the building, street parking and, at night, parking in nearby lots.

**Student Lounge** - Our student lounge is a place where you can get a drink, change your shoes or relax with your friends before or after class.
