

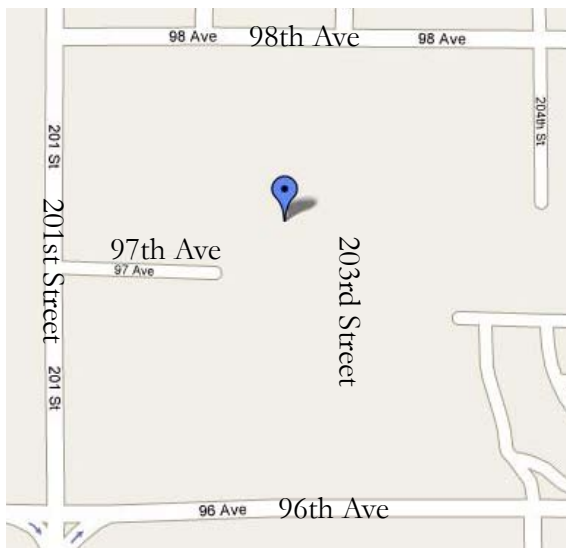


## NEW STUDIO!

### Paso Doble

The man is the matador and the lady the cape (or Spanish Lady) in the dramatic Paso Doble.

### Night Club 2-Step

Tue16 - 7:00, Sun21 - 10:00, Tue30 - 7:00, Sun4 - 10:00

NC 2-step is a slow romantic dance that is perfect for songs that are too slow for foxtrot or rumba. We'll focus on good rhythm and remembering the romance!

### Two-Step

A little twang in your step is good for the inner cowperson! Two-step is similar to foxtrot in rhythm, but also uses turns borrowed from swing. Bring your cowboy hat and boots for a Yeeehaaa! good time. (We will be offering Two-Step 2 in February).

### Single Jive

Wed17 - 7:00, Thu18 - 7:30, Sat20 - 12:00, Sat3 - 12:00

Single Jive is perfect for those really fast big-band swings where a triple rhythm becomes difficult. We will show you how to adapt triple rhythm steps and also add some steps specifically for the Single Jive.
